Dragon boat race

It's a summer event held in each regional area to pray for a good catch, scheduled on a Sunday (June or July) after May 4th in the lunar calendar. For the exact date, please check the Uruma City website.

Event schedule June or July every year
(Sunday after May 4th in the lunar calendar)


Zento Shishimai (Lion Dance) Festival

Shishimai (lion dance) is a traditional event that has been carried out throughout Okinawa to ward off evil spirits and bring a bountiful harvest. At this Zento *Shishimai* Festival, you can see brave *shishimai* dance performances selected from each region of the prefecture.

Event schedule Around October every year
(around September 15th in the lunar calendar)





Uruma City Product Festival

This is an event to collect agricultural and marine products, and local produce. There is also a craft exhibition and traditional performing arts performances on stage.

Event schedule Around January every year



Uruma City Eisa Festival

In Uruma City where *eisa* (drum dance performance) is active, this festival is becoming one of the biggest events for each youth association. Every costume and performance is unique, and it's exciting to watch.

Event schedule August or September every year
(July in the lunar calendar)

During the festival, a wide variety of programs such as local traditional art performances and a live concert by splendid artists is offered. The final item on the program is a spectacular fireworks display that lights up the autumn night.
