Visit the legendary well, believed to have been discovered by pigeons. Nestled under a sea-facing cliff, this natural spring trickles from the rocks, collected in a traditional well.

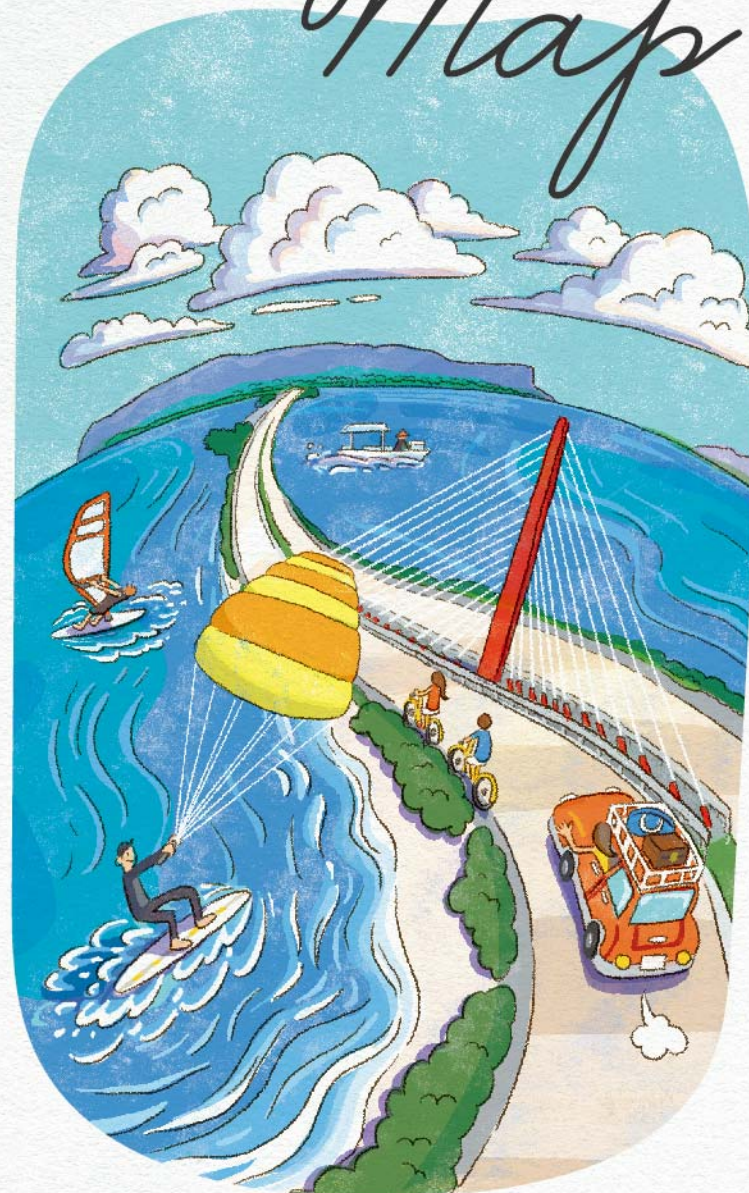
